2020 Development Committee Annual Report

The Tri-Valley Development Fund received contributions from 44 employees through the payroll deduction option during the 2020 fiscal year. In addition to payroll deduction funds, additional credit card payments and one-time donations were given by outside individuals and businesses. At the close of fiscal year 2020, a total of \$4,919.15 had been donated to the Tri-Valley Development Fund, bringing the total Development Fund to \$10,532.79. Funds were distributed throughout 2020 totaling \$4,707.10 for lobbying (lobbying dues are to support legislative advocacy and lobbying on Tri-Valley's behalf through MinnCAP and the National Migrant & Seasonal Head Start Association). In addition, donations were made to the NCAF COVID-19 Relief Fund, the Early Childhood Initiative, and to our co-workers who had been affected by an unforeseen emergency in 2020.

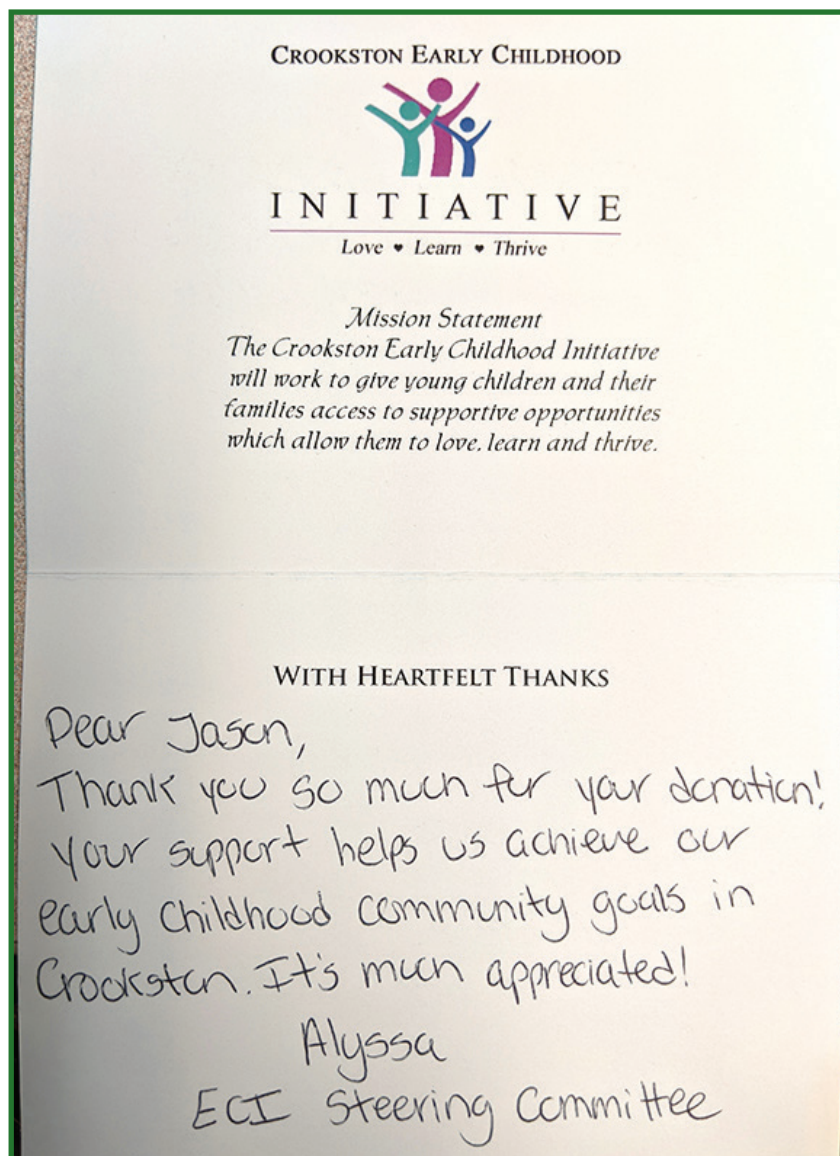
