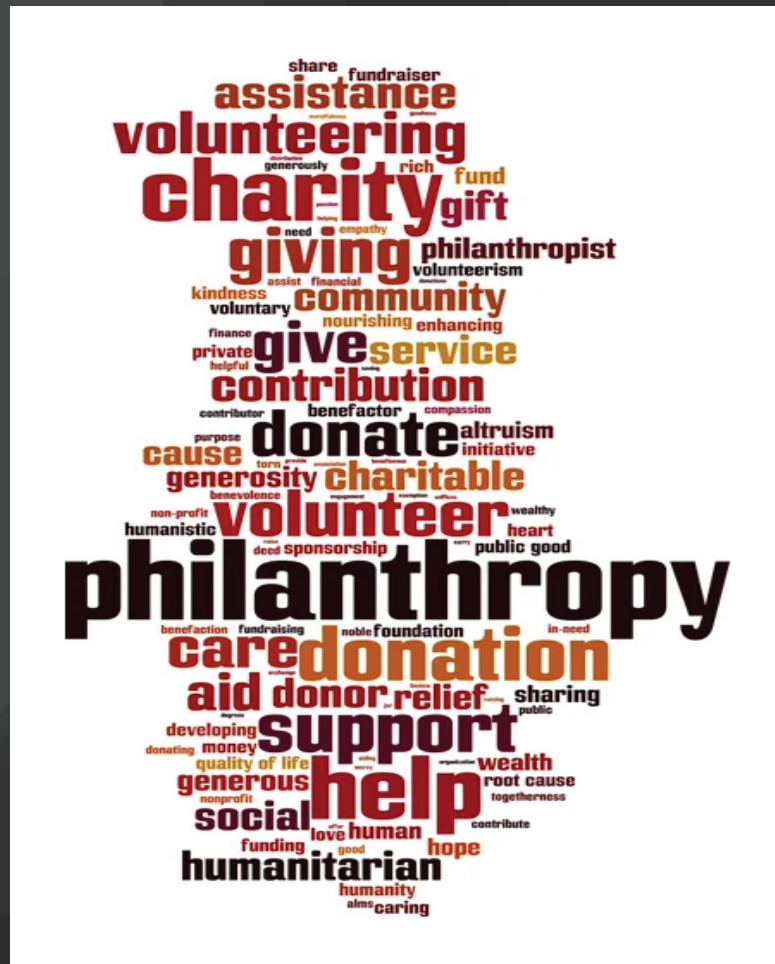
**Tri-Valley**

The Tri-Valley Development Fund received contributions from 38 employees through the payroll deduction option totaling \$4,323.00 during the 2025 fiscal year. In addition to payroll funds, money was received from two private donations in the amount of \$1,200. Funds were distributed throughout 2025 totaling \$6482.78 for an ending balance of \$9,951.27 (this includes \$3,175.00 earmarked for a Laurie Coleman Memorial to be determined at a later date). Distributions included a food donation to the Care & Share, a donation to the Crookston Early Childhood Initiative, lobbying dues, through the Minnesota Community Action Partnership (MinnCAP), to continue lobbying efforts crucial to serving those in our communities that need our help, and donations to several Tri-Valley staff that experienced an emergency/hardship/loss of a loved one in 2025.
